



Resolution II.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and due to the measures, which greatly affect the cross boarder travel, the President of the Constitutional Court of the Czech Republic, the Court currently presiding over the Conference of European Constitutional Courts, called for the decision of the Circle of Presidents to be taken by way of a circular resolution.

Based on the correspondence voting held from 18 November 2020 to 9 December 2020 and in accordance with Art. 9 para 4. of the Conference Regulations of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts the Circle of Presidents

decided by way of circular resolution

to approve the following:

Bearing in mind all the measures adopted by the authorities to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic the number of participants of the XVIII Congress of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts will be limited to full member courts and associate members of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts, whereas only the following persons and institutions shall be invited as observers to the XVIII Congress:

- President of the European Court of Human Rights and the judge of the European Court of Human Rights elected for the Czech Republic;
- President of the Court of Justice of the European Union;
- President of the European Commission for Democracy through Law (the Venice Commission);
- World Conference on Constitutional Justice (WCCJ);
- Presidents of constitutional and equivalent courts currently applying for some form of membership in the CECC.
