

## Resolution

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and due to the measures taken by the authorities to stop the crisis the XVIII<sup>th</sup> Congress of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts (CECC) cannot be held in the originally approved date (Art. 1 Resolution II. of the Circle of Presidents of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts, gathered in Prague in preparation of the XVIIIth Congress of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts on June 13, 2018);

In view of that fact the President of the Constitutional Court of the Czech Republic, the Court currently presiding over the Conference of European Constitutional Courts, called for the decision of the Circle of Presidents to be taken by way of a circular resolution;

Based on the correspondence voting held from 24 March 2020 to 15 April 2020 and in accordance with Art. 9 para 4. of the Conference Regulations of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts the Circle of Presidents

decided by way of circular resolution

to approve the following matters:

- 1) The XVIII<sup>th</sup> Congress of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts is postponed for February 2021.
- 2) The organizer (the Constitutional Court of the Czech Republic) will set up the precise date of the XVIII<sup>th</sup> Congress of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts and will ask the members of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts to approve the new date as soon as possible.
- 3) The presidency of the Constitutional Court of the Czech Republic over the Conference of European Constitutional Courts will be extended until 2021.
- 4) The Constitutional Court of the Republic of Moldova will preside over the Conference of European Constitutional Courts from 2021 to 2024.

Based on the correspondence voting held from 24 March 2020 to 15 April 2020 and in accordance with Art. 9 para 4. of the Conference Regulations of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts the Circle of Presidents

decided by way of circular resolution

to approve:

- 5) Ms. Silvana Sciarra, Judge of the Constitutional Court of the Italian Republic, to be the speaker at the 5<sup>th</sup> Congress of World conference on Constitutional Justice nominated by the Conference of European Constitutional Courts, currently represented by the Constitutional Court of the Czech Republic in the Bureau of World conference on Constitutional Justice.
