

Dear Madam President, Dear Mister President,

in my capacity as President of the Constitutional Court of the Czech Republic, currently chairing the Conference of the European Constitutional Courts (CECC), I have received the attached letter from Ms Arta Rama-Hajrizi, the President of the Constitutional Court of Kosovo, together with documents recorded on USB flash drive.

I wish to bring the letter to your attention, as it contains the application of the Constitutional Court of Kosovo for the status of the Associate Member of CECC. The attachments are available through the estorage link.

The Constitutional Court of Kosovo expressly asked its application for the status of the Associate Member of CECC be considered at the XVIIIth Congress of CECC. Moreover, there is not enough time to be acquainted with all the documents attached and to make necessary consultations thereto. That is why I am not going to change the already circulated draft Agenda for the Circle of Presidents preparatory meeting on June 13th, 2018 in Prague.

With respect to the statement of the Constitutional Court of Kosovo and with the need for reasonable time for our internal deliberation I would refer the application of the Constitutional Court of Kosovo to the Agenda of Circle of Presidents held on the day preceding the opening of the XVIIIth Congress of CECC (Art. 9 sec. 4 of Statute of the CECC).
