

Resolution VI

The Circle of Presidents of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts, having convened to the Preparatory Meeting of the XIVth Congress of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts on 7 September 2006 in Vilnius,

Taking account of the request of the Supreme Court of the State of Israel to admit it to Full Membership in the Conference of European Constitutional Courts,

Having heard the assenting and dissenting opinions of the participants of the Preparatory Meeting,

Having held that a majority of not less than two-thirds of votes of members participating in the meeting, as required by Article 9.7a of the Statute, has not approved of the decision to admit the Supreme Court of the State of Israel to Full Membership in the Conference of European Constitutional Courts,

has resolved:

To retain in force Resolution IV regarding an application submitted by the Supreme Court of the State of Israel for Full Membership in the Conference of European Constitutional Courts adopted during the Preparatory Meeting for the XIIIth Congress of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts which took place on 16-17 October 2003 in Nicosia.
